## DRESS CODE

### Rationale

We all need to belong and belonging enables us to be identified with a certain group. A dress code, and in particular a uniform, provides identity and enables us to be identified as members of St Anne's College.

### Definition

This dress code is St Anne's College statement for expectations regarding student appearance, that:

- Applies during school hours
- While travelling to and from school
- When students are engaged in school activities out of school hours
- Defines standards for the general presentation of students
- Sets out broad guidelines about student appearance
- Requires students to wear a school uniform
- Defines specifications for garment design and colour.

### Basic Beliefs

Students need to be in comfortable and practical clothing for the many activities associated with learning.

Parents can readily access uniforms that are affordable, offer value for money and provide a stress free choice, as children get ready for school.

As St Anne's College we need to be identified amongst our peers and within our community – a uniform does just that.

We believe that a dress code, with a required uniform, promotes a sense of identity and pride along with a cohesion and good order within St Anne's College.

**St Anne's College dress code:**

- Allows all students to feel equal
- Helps prevent bullying and competition on the basis of clothing
- Ensures students' appearance reflects the expectations of St Anne's College
- Enhances the profile and identity of St Anne's and its students within the wider community
- Strengthens the spirit of community within the St Anne's College
- Enhances individual student safety and group security
- Ensures all students are dressed safely and appropriately for school activities
- Encourages students to develop pride in their appearance
- Prepares students for the expectations of workplaces
- Encourages students to present themselves appropriately for a particular role.

**Guidelines for implementation**

- All members of St Anne's College will present themselves in clean, well-dressed clothes.
- Wearing a uniform will aide acceptable dress and is required at all times.
- Those who attend St Anne's College without the correct uniform need to bring a note explaining why they are not in correct dress code.
- Clothes must be clearly and permanently marked with the child's name.
- Jewellery is not permitted, except for studs or sleepers in the case of students with pierced ears - one per ear only.
- If children have long hair it must be fastened tidily, using ties in College colours
- Hair must be the child's natural colour and of an acceptable style.
- Facial hair must be neat and trimmed
- Make up, if needed, must be neutral and minimal.
- Nail polish, if needed is to be neutral or clear.

Shirt Unisex: Long and Short Sleeve silver with orange trim, logo on pocket

Dress: navy with silver, orange pin stripe check, orange piping on sleeves and collar

Skirt: navy, pleat

Pullover: navy with orange trim on V-neck collar.

Soft Shell Jacket: navy, sublimated orange panel, silver piping, with logo

Socks / tights: navy

Black leather shoe

Bucket Hat: navy, with logo

Sports Shorts: navy with logo

Polo top: navy, sublimated orange panel, silver piping, with logo

Track pants: dark navy fleece with logo

Socks: Navy crew

### **Upper Years: Nine to Twelve:**

Tailored short: Navy, fly front with logo

Shirt Unisex: Long and Short Sleeve silver with orange trim, logo on pocket

Dress: navy with silver, orange pin stripe check, white collar, orange piping on sleeves and collar, logo on pocket

Skirt: navy, with orange stripes, pleat

Pullover: navy with orange trim on V-neck collar.

Tie: silver with orange and navy diagonal stripe

Soft Shell Jacket: navy, sublimated orange panel, silver piping, with logo

Socks / tights: navy

Black leather shoe

Bucket Hat: navy, with logo

Sports Shorts: navy with logo  
Polo top: orange, sublimated navy panel, silver piping, with logo  
Track pants: dark navy fleece with logo
