Tuition fees are inclusive of sports, excursions, and all curriculum needs.

A three day camp for Year 7 is also included in the tuition fees. No refund is possible for non-attendance at camp. Year 7 may require additional subject specific stationery.

All students in Year 7 will have individual access to a laptop. A computer levy of \$400 is inclusive of the tuition fee. If a student leaves the school during the year, there will be no pro-rata refund on the computer levy. The College will maintain laptops. If the laptop is damaged, you will be charged a \$300 insurance excess. Foundation students will have access to class sets of a Technology device at various times during the year.

As part of our commitment to providing a learning experience that is at the very forefront of education in this technological society, we will endeavour to access the majority of our learning resources online or via computer programs. This means students will not receive a booklist, which is a significant cost saving for each family. The cost of the online programs used within Numeracy, Literacy and Languages are included in the tuition fees.

Fee Payment Methods and Due Dates

The fees are charged annually in January. School fees are to be paid by direct debit via credit card or bank account. These fees can be paid weekly, fortnightly or monthly.

Withdrawal of Students from the College

It is assumed that if a student leaves during the term, fees will be paid to the end of that term, this requirement may be waived by the Principal.
