Student Bus Travel 2026

Students have access to two bus services within the Shepparton and surrounding areas which support travel to St Anne's College.

1. School Bus Program Country Bus Service

This service is provided for students who live outside the Mooroopna or Shepparton/Kialla townships and are not serviced by the School Town Bus Special Services (below - 2. School Town Bus Special Services).

The areas covered by this service include Tatura, Undera, Toolamba, Dhurringile, Ardmona and Murchison, Dookie, Bayunga, St Germain's, Numurkah, Yabba North, Pine Lodge, Kyabram, Nalinga, Nagambie, Karramomus, Marungi, Zeerust, Katandra West, Youanmite, Harston, Shepparton East, Dunbulbalane, Tallygaroopna, Bunbartha, Burton Hall, Coomboona, Caniambo and Arcadia.

To travel using this service, parents are required to complete an application form and return it to St Anne's College. Parents will be notified by the Shepparton District School Bus Program Coordinator via email once their child has been allocated to a bus service.

To be eligible for travel to St Anne's College on a school bus, students must attend their nearest catholic school and reside 4.8km or more from the campus.

St Anne's College students not attending their closest catholic school will be required to pay a fare each term as set by Public Transport Victoria.

Please return completed Bus forms with your enrolment documents to St Anne's College and these will be provided to the Shepparton District School Bus Program Coordinator who is responsible for reviewing and accessing all applications.

2. School Town Bus Special Services

This service is provided for students who live in Mooroopna/Shepparton/Kialla and live within 1.6kms of public transport.

Details of these services will be available in Term 4 2025. Parents are responsible for contacting the bus operators below to discuss arrangements to support their child's travel to St Anne's College:
